What's New?

November is right around the corner and work is moving along at Grant Regional Health Center. There will soon be garage doors installed at the new Ambulance Garage, new doors for the Education Department, and structural steel set for the new Clinic / Med Surge addition. There is a great deal of interior work happening as well. The new Education Area is now receiving its accessories and final coats of paint. The Emergency Department expansion is being painted now, and the pharmacy area walls and mechanicals are being installed. In the weeks ahead, the old rehab lot near Lincoln Street will be re-graded, asphalted, and striped. There will also be new retention ponds and a retaining wall added in that area. Keep an eye out for sidewalk and utility work being completed in that area.

The Past Weeks

- Interior demolition for a new IDF room
- Masonry stairwells and elevator shaft for the new addition
- Doors, accessories, and the ceiling was installed in the Education area
- Continued remodel of the Pharmacy area

Coming Up in the Weeks Ahead

- The steel structure and decking for the Clinic / Med Surge addition
- Backfill around the new Clinic / Med Surge addition structure
- Continued interior demolition and renovation work
- Walls, new flooring, and other updates to the Pharmacy area
- Grading and asphaltting of the old Rehab lot
