#### What's New?


Demolition began in the old Imaging Suite department which will be the new Outpatient Clinic. The CS space has been drywalled out and will have the ceiling grid being installed. It will soon be ready for the finishes to begin installation. The lower level of the new Clinic / Med Surge addition has been painted and many of the ceiling grids have been installed as well. Finishes with follow within the next few weeks. The upper level of the new Clinic / Med Surge addition has drywall installation nearly complete! The north and south ends remain for drywall installation. The above ceiling MEP rough ins continue on and the ceiling grid will be going in soon. Site work has been scheduled as well and will be occurring in the upcoming weeks.

X marks the spot! The crews marked out where demolition was to take place in the existing Radiology Suite or new Outpatient Clinic. This is part of the preplanning process to ensure work goes quickly and smoothly.





The demolition of the new Outpatient Clinic is well underway! The photo on the left was taken a week before the photo on the right, the difference is many existing clay tile walls were removed and the space is being cleaned up / cleared for stud wall framing to begin.
